DO'S & DON'TS



*Positively **NO ONE** is allowed on Waneta Lake.

***Do not cross the road.** Always use the tunnels!

(All Winteree activities are on the main side of the camp - there should be no need to cross the road!!)

DO: “BALOO” is in full effect throughout the Five Rivers Council. Units wanting the use of a facility must make their own reservations with the appropriate fee at the Council Service Center in the Arnot Mall.

DO: Bring a Bag Lunch or Cash for a delicious meal from the Order of the Arrow!

DO: Bring a Drinking Cup for every person in attendance

DO: Bring 1 Adult per 10 boys. This is in addition to the requirement of two-deep leadership.

DO: Bring Sleds, Saucers, and Toboggans for afternoon sledding if conditions allow. The Camp Ranger will designate the area! All sledding must be done with Unit Leader/Adult Supervision. Scouts sledding unsupervised will be sent home.

DON'T: The use and/or possession of drugs, alcohol, fireworks or unauthorized firearms, is strictly forbidden. All scouting activities are also **Tobacco Free.**

DO: Abide by scouting's Leave No Trace. Please leave wildlife and habitats alone. Pick up after yourself!

DO: Consider purchasing lunch from the Order of the Arrow. Units must pre-purchase meal tickets at registration. This allows the OA to prepare the right amount of food and give you faster food service at lunchtime!!

Throughout the day, Coffee, Hot Cocoa & Water will be available.

BYOC - To reduce costs, please bring your own drinking cups to use all day.
Foam cups are available for \$0.25 each.
